AKI Alert, Detection Algorithm

Trust labs are busy implementing the new software in the path lab systems. We are now entering an exciting phase of data collection which means that for the first time we will have information about the size and scale of the challenge AKI presents. Read more about the Patient Safety Alert which generated the changes here. Primary Care & Commissioning AKI Workshop 24 March 2015

Designed to help increase our knowledge of levels of understanding of AKI in primary care 60+ delegates comprising GPs, commissioners and improvement experts participated to help determine the strategy that will develop the primary care solutions for acute kidney injury that focus on the pathway.
