
Check for Urine Infection








If urine is dark – give extra fluids. Check for bowels open Are any of these symptoms present?



Urgent need to pass urine/incontinent when not usually



Confused more than usual when not usually



Feeling feverish and unwell



Low tummy or suprapubic pain

Prolonged contact with urine can encourage urine infection. Therefore, it is important to ensure that Incontinence Pads are changed in a timely way

Clients with urinary catheters are likely to have bacteria in their urine – encourage fluids
