AKI = A sudden and recent reduction in a persons kidney function

AKI RISK FACTORS:

- Sepsis
- Dehydration
- Nephrotoxic drugs (see care bundle)
- Radiocontrast

AKI RISK FACTORS:

- Chronic kidney disease
 - Advanced age/cognitive impairment
 - Generalised arteriopathy
 - Previous AKI

Nurses AKI (Acute Kidney Injury) Know your role!

If your patient has an AKI alert on ICE or AKI is communicated to you by the medical team:

YOU NEED TO START THE AKI 8 CARE BUNDLE

 Inform the doctor as soon as possible and nurse in charge

- Start fluid balance chart
- Perform urine dip stick
- Discuss with the patient (where appropriate)
