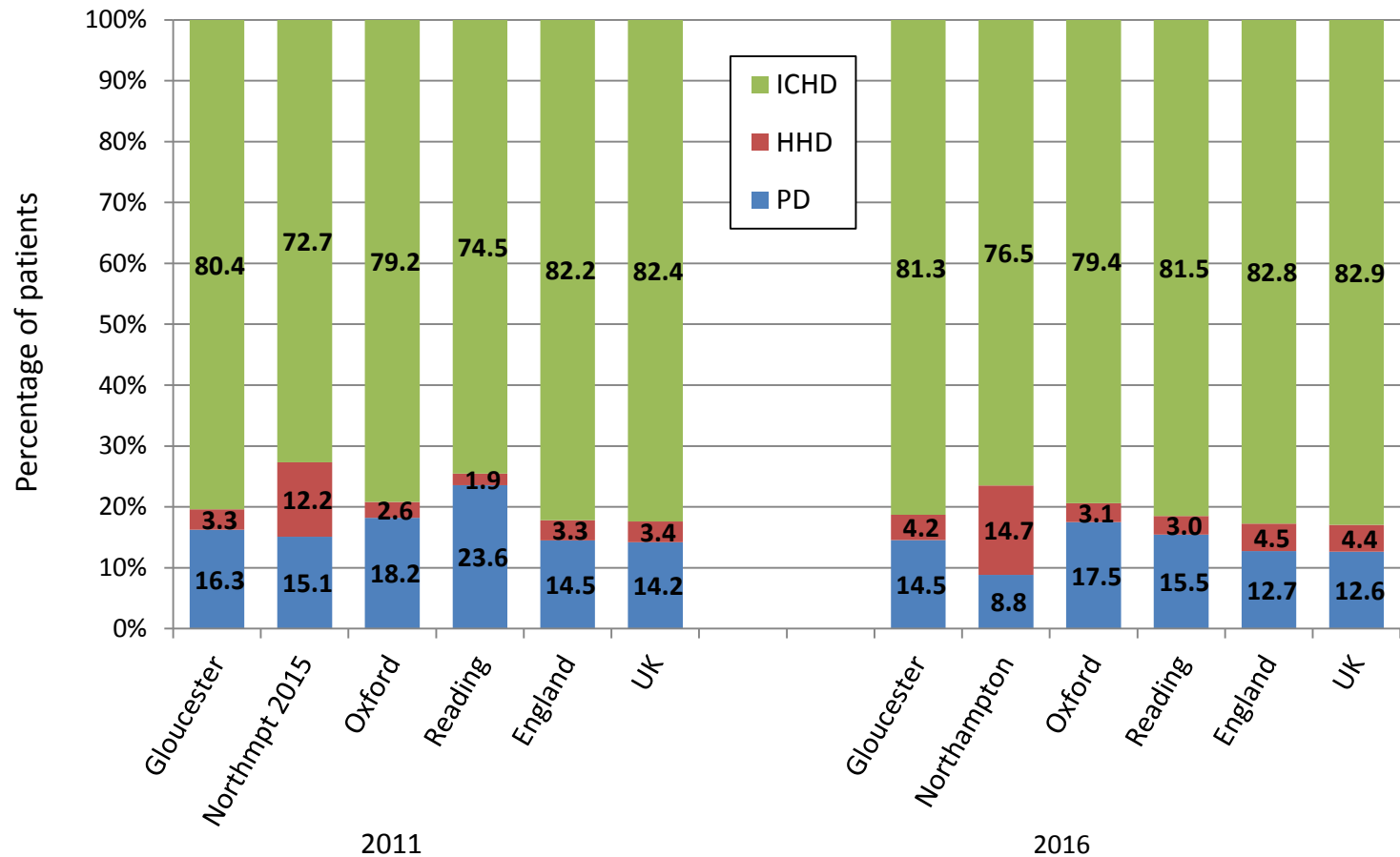

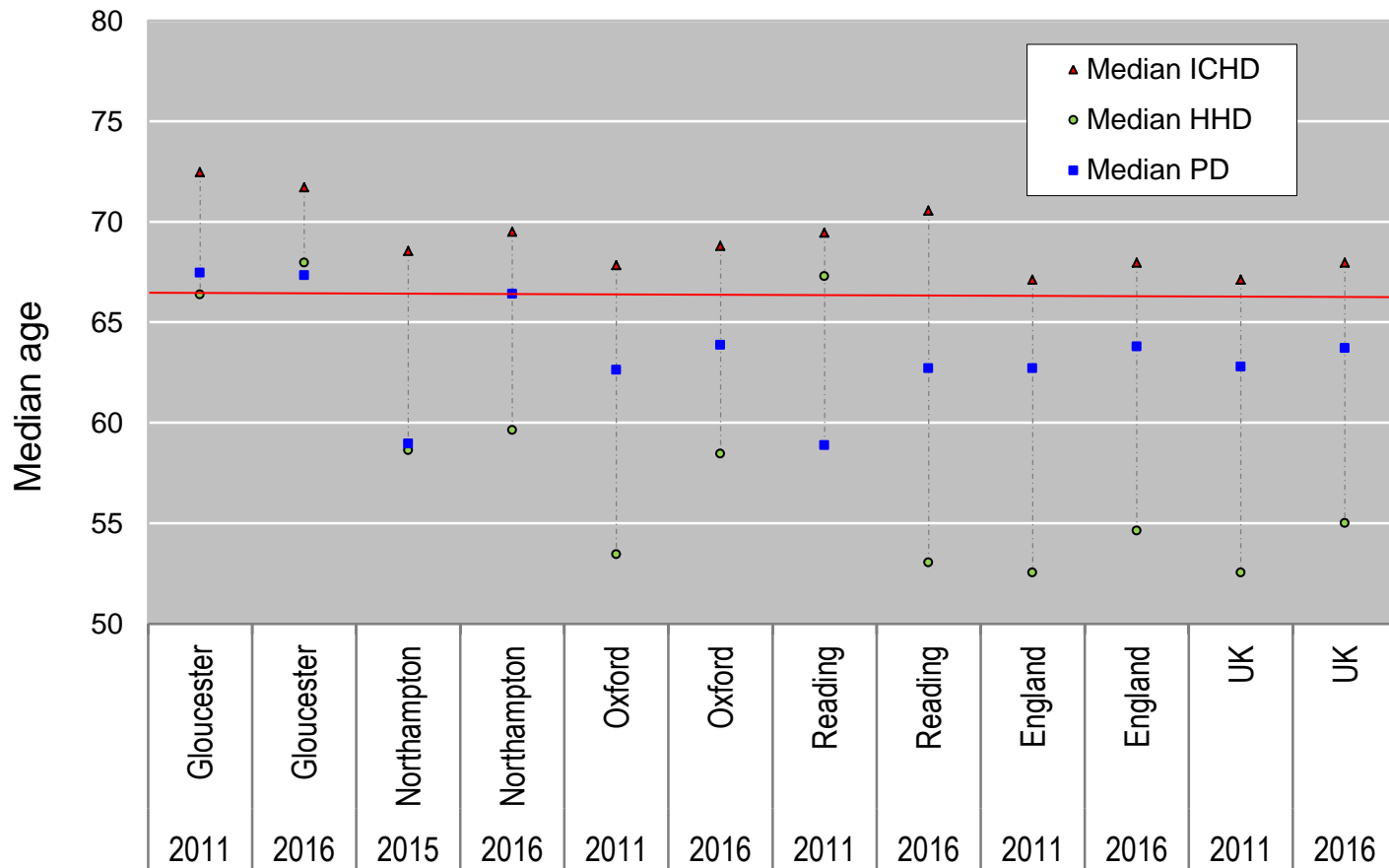

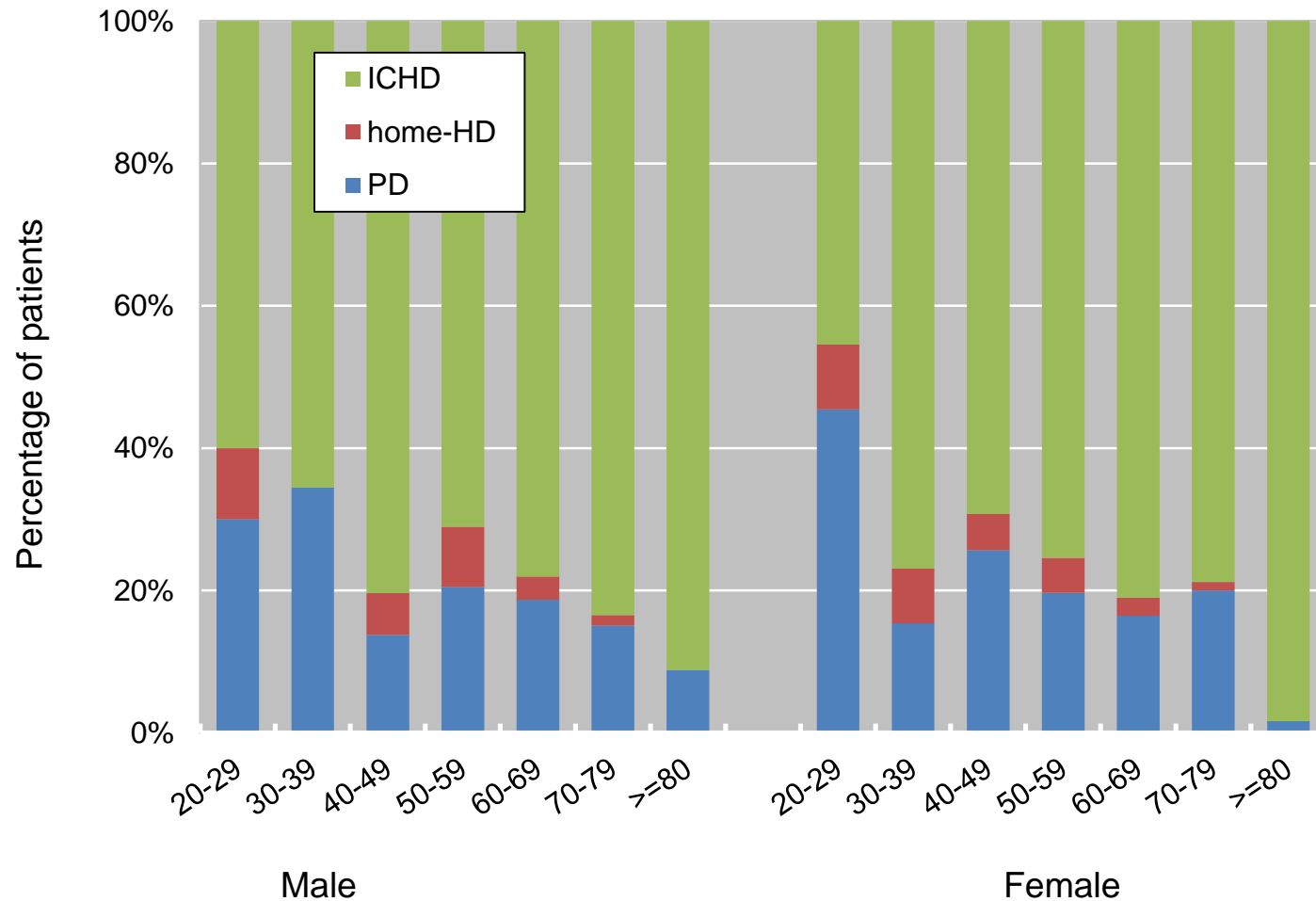
Percentage of prevalent dialysis patients by modality and centre on 31 December 2011 and 2016



Median age in prevalent dialysis patients by modality and centre on 31 December 2011 and 2016

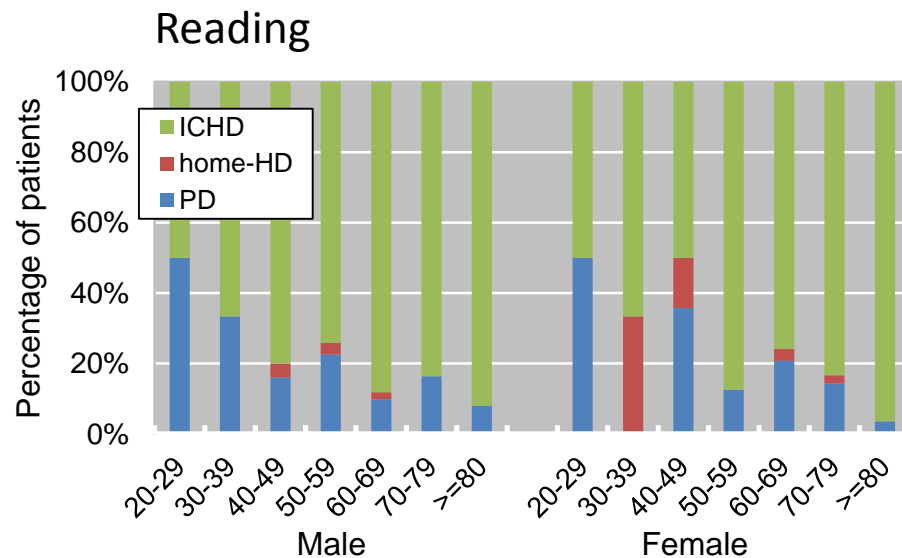
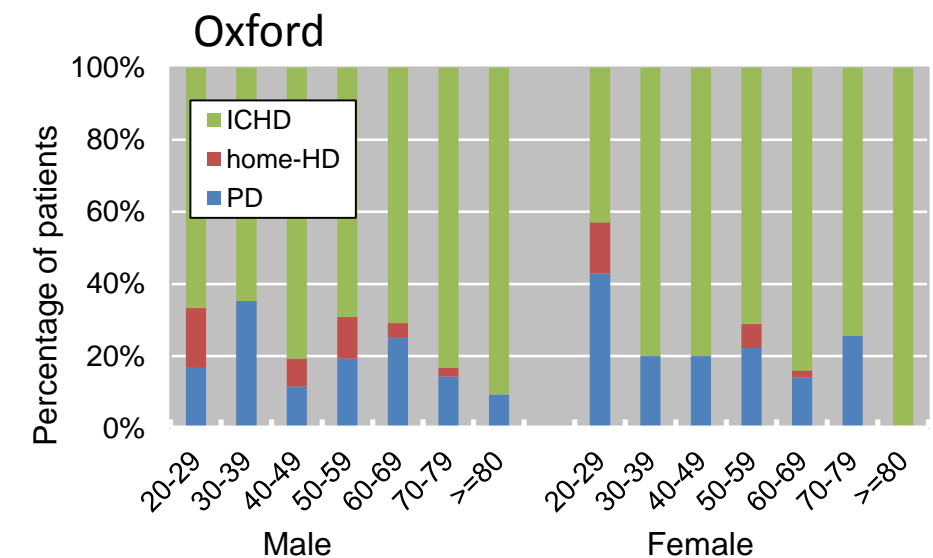
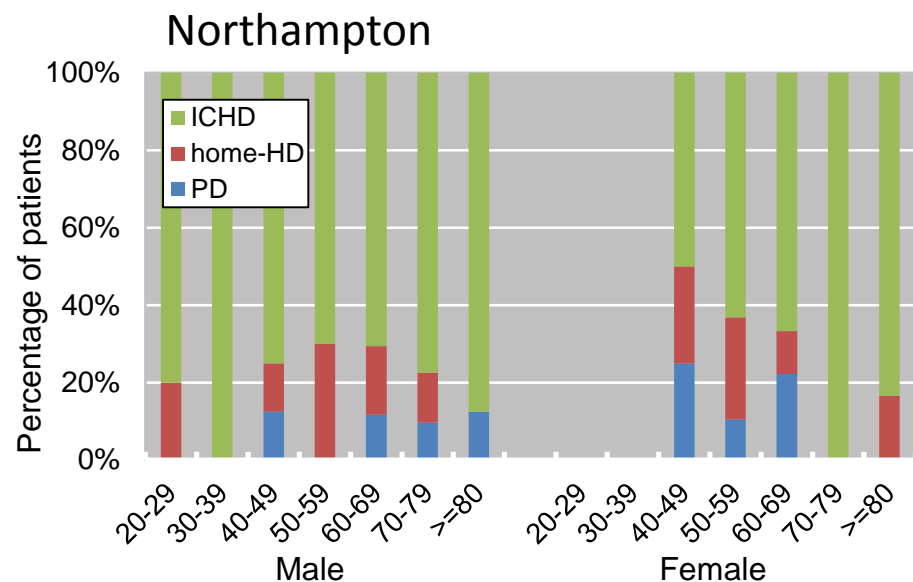
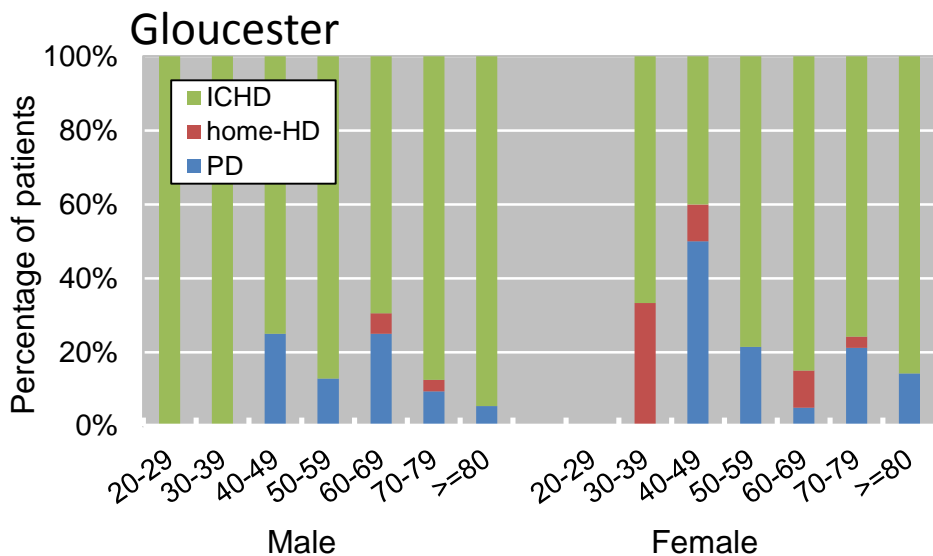


Percentage of prevalent dialysis patients by modality, age and gender on 31 December 2016

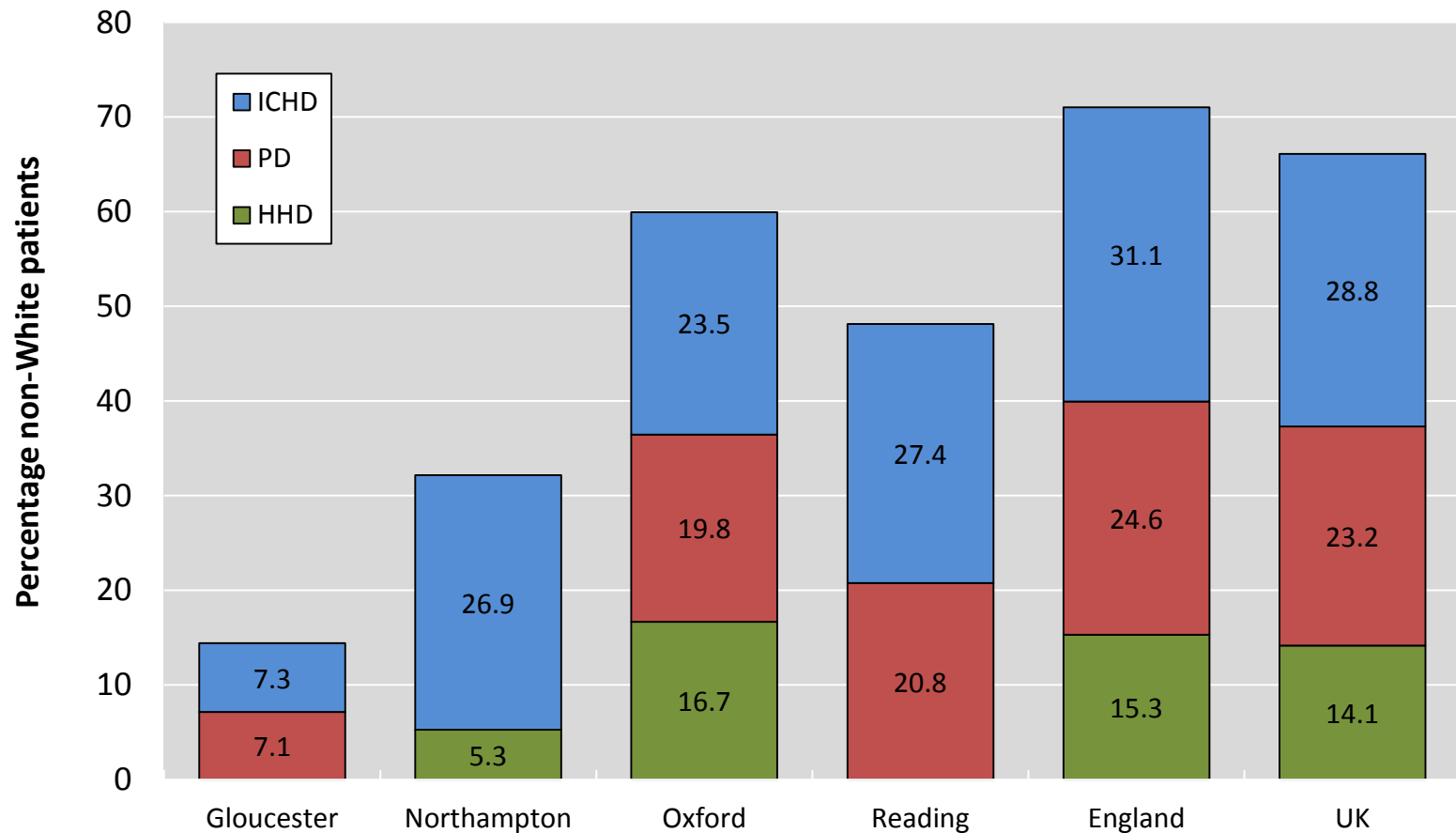




Percentage of prevalent dialysis patients by modality, age and gender on 31 December 2016

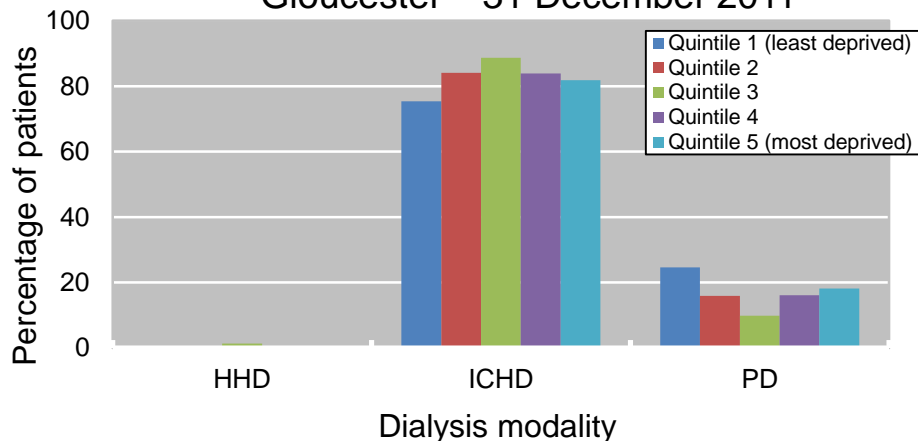


Percentage of prevalent dialysis patients by modality, ethnicity and centre on 31 December 2016

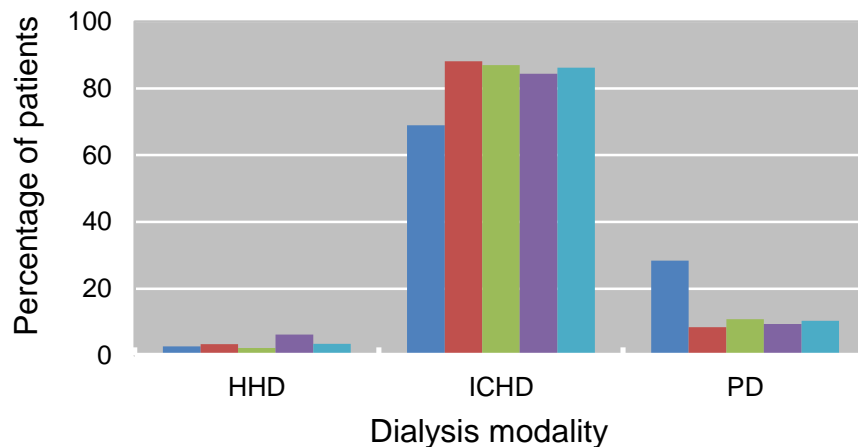


Percentage of prevalent dialysis patients by modality, social deprivation and centre in 2011 and 2016

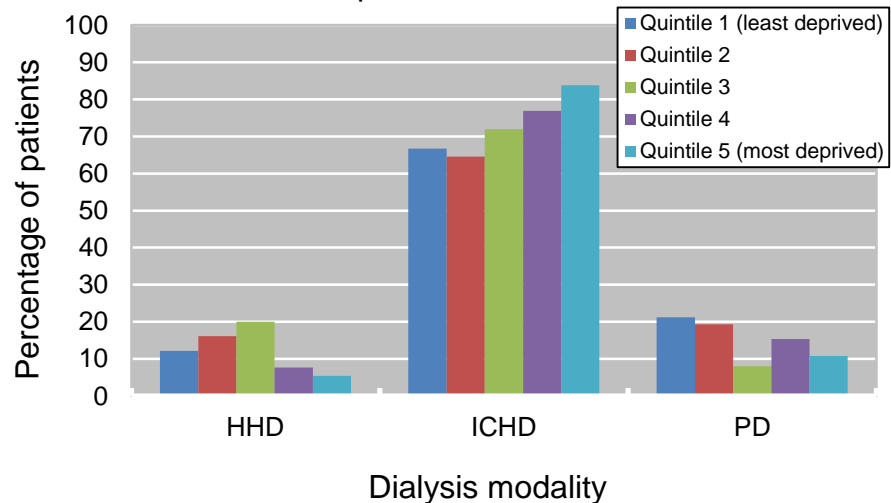

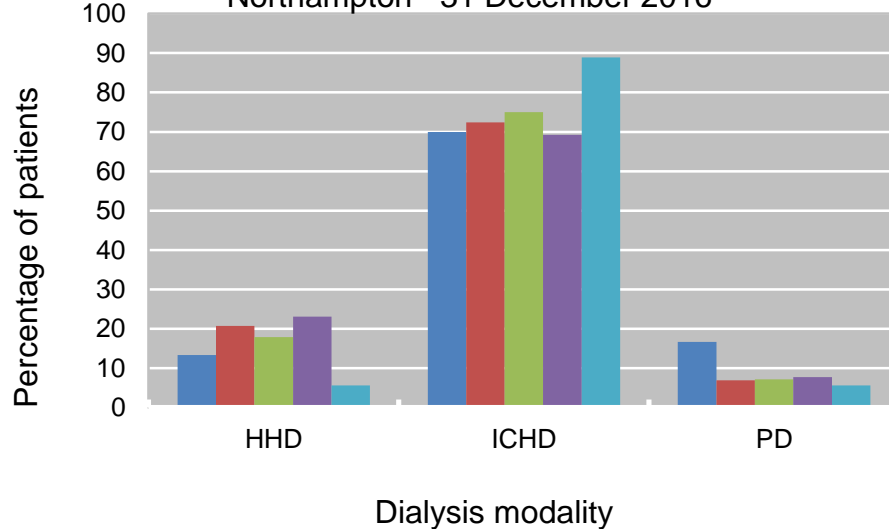

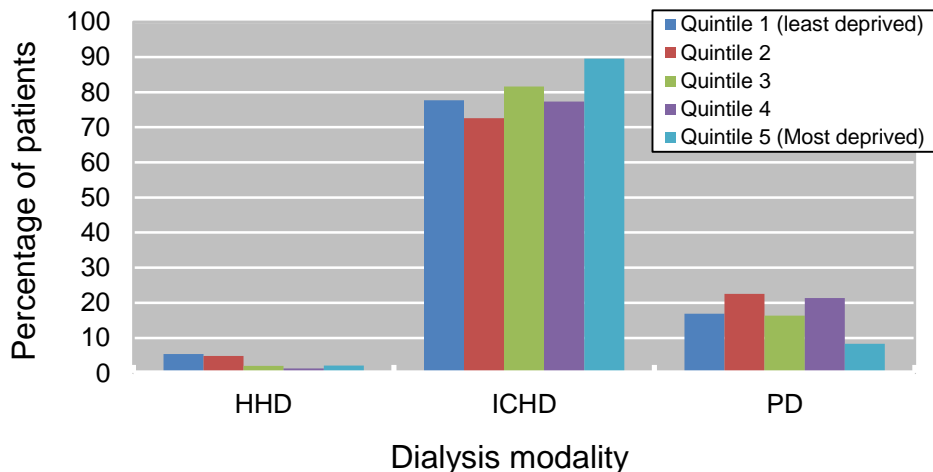

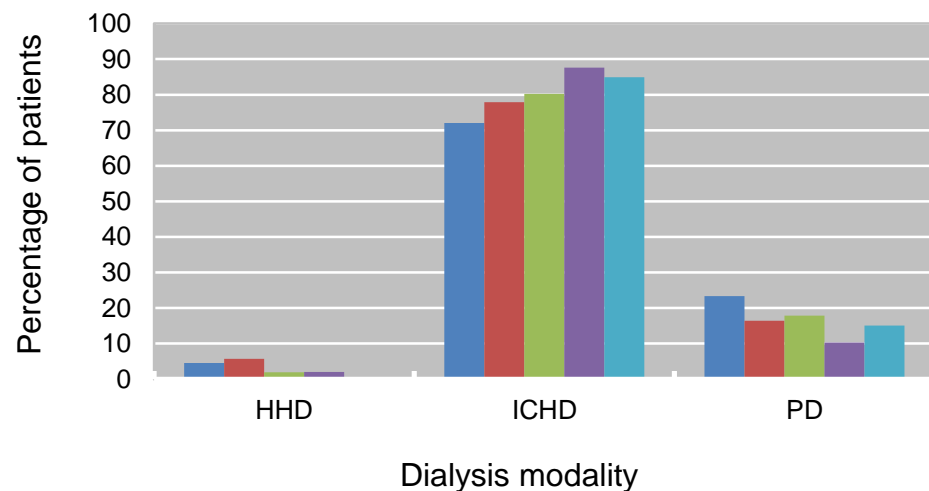


Percentage of prevalent dialysis patients by modality, social deprivation and centre in 2011 and 2016

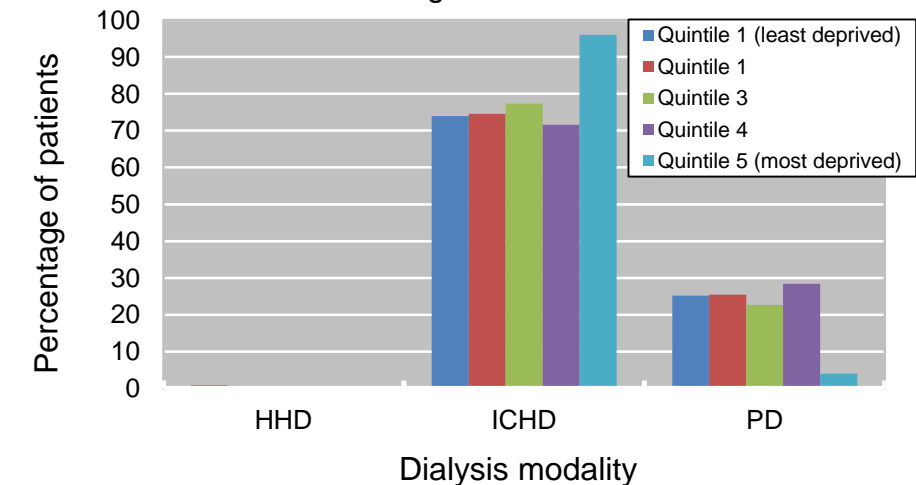
Oxford - 31 December 2011



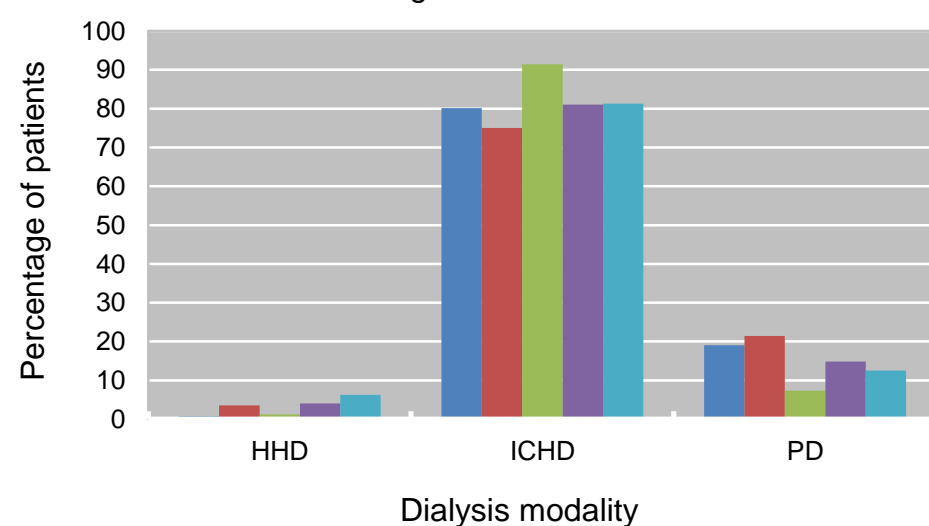

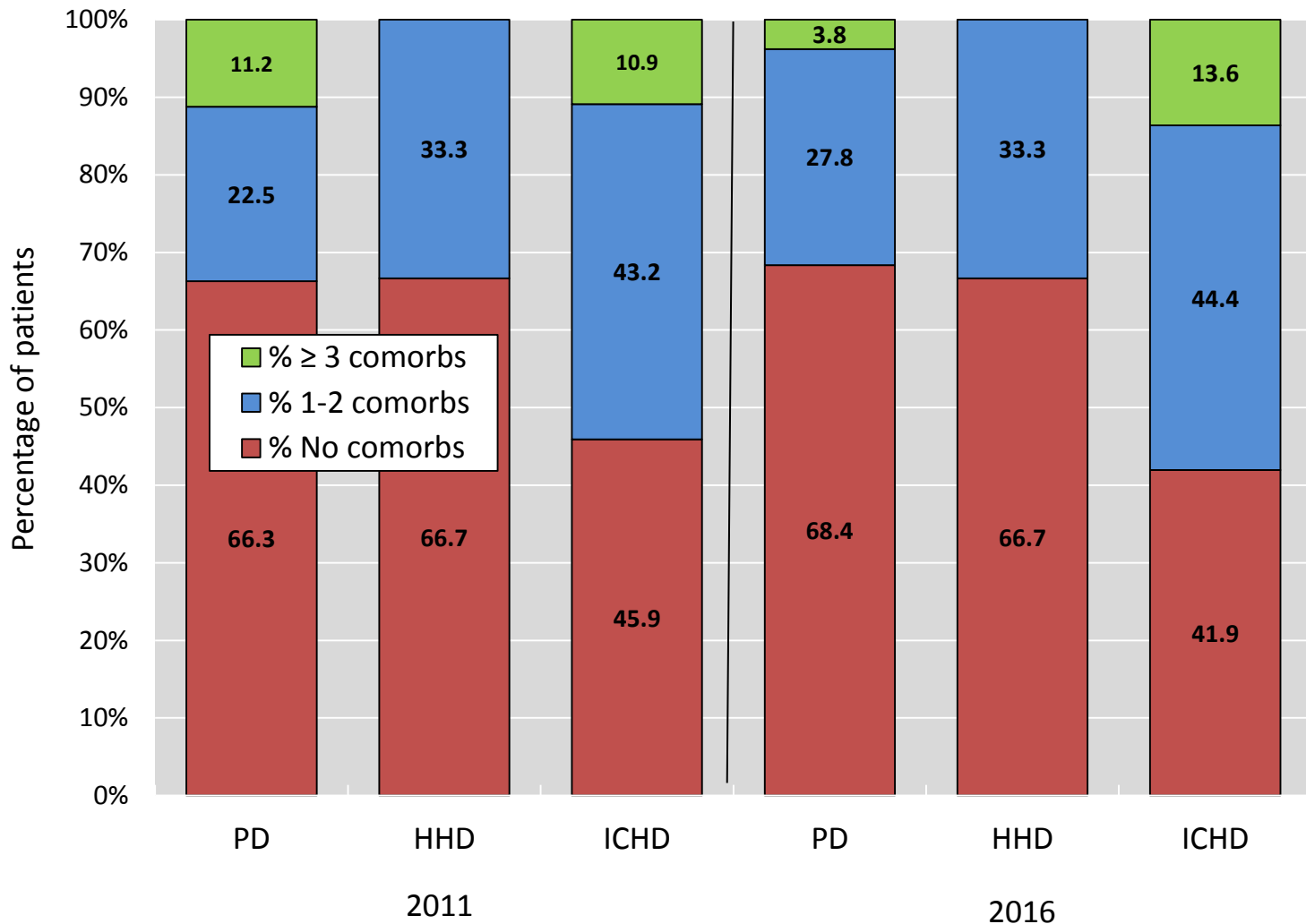

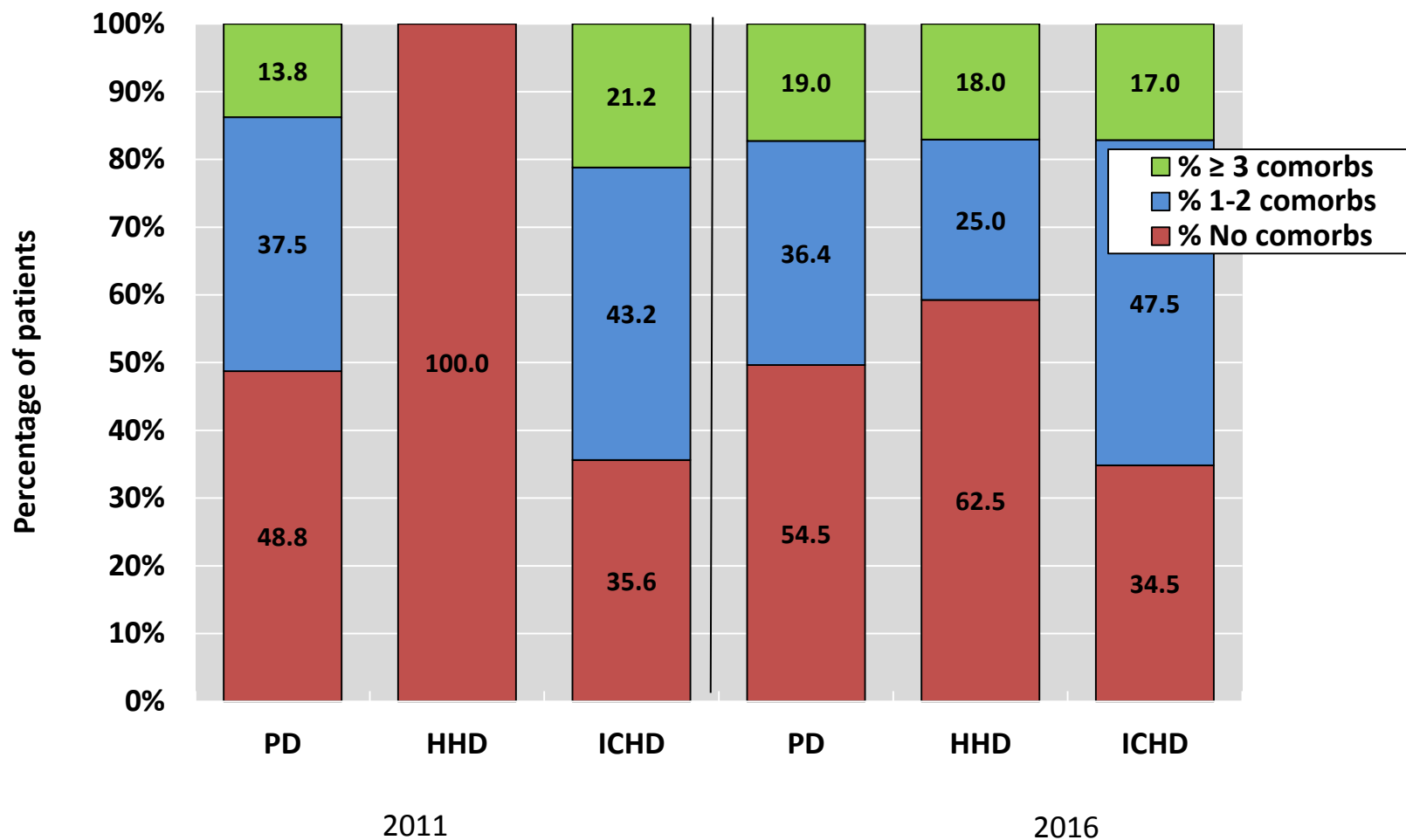
