#### Were we are now

- 71% AVF prevalence
- 12 month 70-78%
- To improve

1. More patients to start with a working AVF. Addressing this via audit and action plan

2. Implement Magic to promote good cannulation practice and improve patient experience. In a bit to prolong AVF longevity
