- The impact of prevention agenda on overall take on rates - RG to FU with UKRR
- What is happening about national waiting list? LD rates (14.2) / DD rates (36.9) SD to FU with NHSBT
- The GIRFT regional outcomes to inform SW Team Tx—RG to bring to next meeting
- What is Teeside doing that can be shared? RG/SD to FU with Caroline Wroe
- Agree regional clock start – date of 1st appointment—SD to action
- Concerns around isotope availability due to Brexit—discussion
- Bottle necks around cardiology – how are cardiology services commissioned and where is the funding held? Local QI lead to FU internally
- Problem with coding of clinics making activity unaccounted for—Local QI lead to action
- Do we need to agree a regional approach to cardiology requirements – if so how do we start the conversation and who do we include? Bring to next meeting
- Look at additional funding streams at Trust level to address issues such as: Transformation funds /Sustainability and Resilience funds.
- Start to involve clinical service managers in the project regionally as well as locally.
