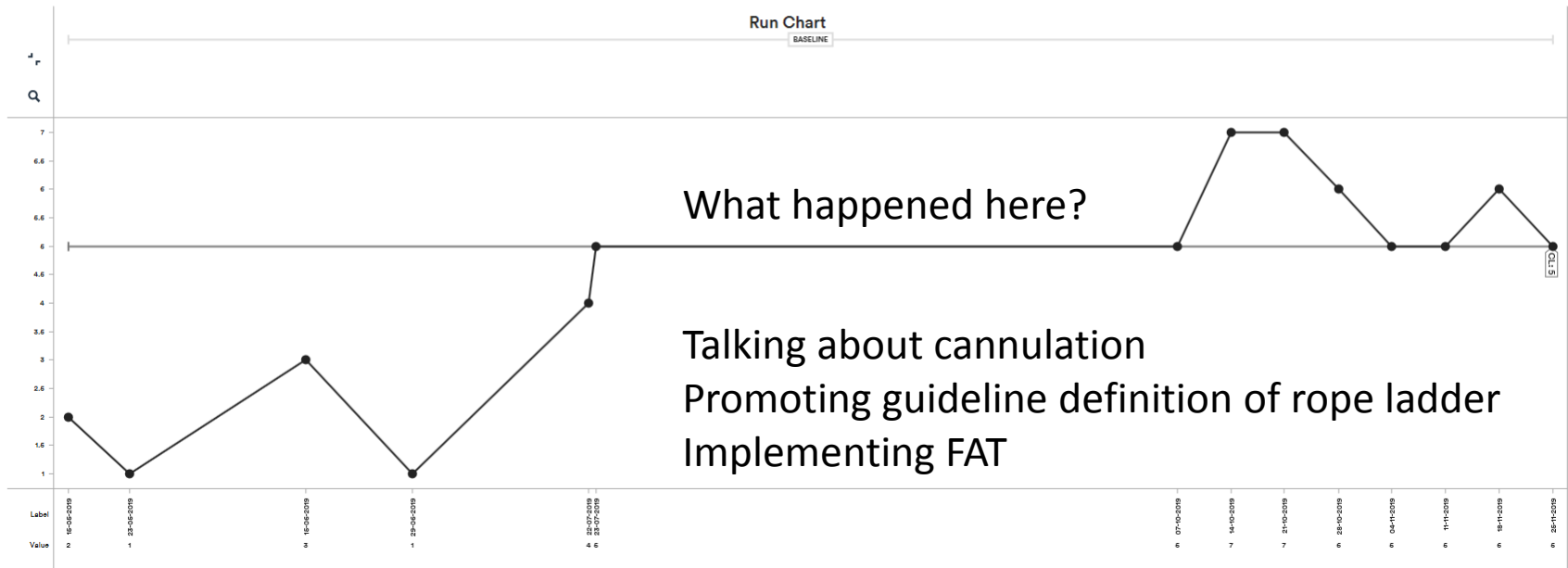


## Run Chart – Frequency of Rope Ladder and Buttonhole Cannulation (Beeston)
